Professor (August 1992). Department of Construction Engineering. School of Civil Engineering of Barcelona (Escuela Técnica Superior de Ingenieros de Caminos, Canales y Puertos). Polytechnic University of Catalonia-UPC. Barcelona, Spain (area of Steel Structures)

He taught and is teaching the disciplines of Structural Concrete , Structural Steel and Composite Structures , in different courses of the degree of Civil Engineer, Master of Civil Engineer, Master of Structural Engineering and Construction Engineering , and other master's degrees since 1982

He has developed his research in the field of concrete and steel structures , and specifically in the analysis and design of structures against imposed deformations (thermal actions, creep, shrinkage,...), nonlinear analysis of concrete, steel and composite structures, instability in steel structures, and stainless steel structures

His work in teaching has been positively evaluated six times over five-year periods (30 years)
His research work has been positively evaluated five times over six-year periods (30 years)

He has directed nine doctoral theses

He has published over 180 articles in journals and conferences, national and international

He has published 22 books on topics related to his teaching and research interests

He has been principal investigator in 12 competitive research and development projects funded by different national and European administrations

He has led and participated in more than 70 specific collaboration agreements with companies of the construction sector

Chairman of AEN / CTN 140/SC3 , Eurocode 3, since December 2000 (Spanish Committee)

Chairman of the new Spanish Code for Steel Structures, EAE, since December 2001 till December 2011

He was Head of the Department of Construction Engineering at the Polytechnic University of Catalonia and Vice Dean of the School of Civil Engineering of Barcelona.
